#### From the Navigator

This morning at 10:00am, we are expected to enter Yakutat Bay at Ocean Cape and at approx. 11:30am, Disenchantment Bay at Point Latouche. From approx. 11:30am - 3:00pm, we will be cruising inside Disenchantment Bay, the home of the largest tidewater glacier in Alaska. Hubbard Glacier discharges numerous icebergs into the bay and it depends entirely on the amount of ice in the bay, wind conditions and visibility on how close we can approach the six mile wide face of the glacier. We will leave Yakutat Bay at 4:30pm and spend the rest of the day in the Pacific Ocean. During the evening, depending on visibility, you might spot many mountain tops and glaciers, among them Mount Fairweather (15,320 ft.) and La Perouse Glacier on our port side.

## Hotel Manager: John J. Scheringa

### Glaciers

Alaska has more than 100,000 glaciers covering approximately 30,000 square miles. According to the Alaska Geographic Society, "A glacier is a perennial accumulation of ice, snow, water, rock and sediment that moves under the influence of gravity." The following contribute to the distinctive nature of glaciers:

- 1) Glacial ice and the material it contains;
- 2) The fjord, channel, valley and rock features housing the glacier;
- 3) The deposits produced from glacial advance and retreat.

Glacial ice is formed as snow gradually changes into firn, a bubbly form of ice. The process in which snow becomes glacial ice can take years to complete. The high density of this ice causes it to absorb most of the visible spectrum and reflect primarily blue, thus giving glaciers their blue-white appearance. As a glacier flows, the top 100 to 150 feet deforms, causing elongated cracks called crevasses, resulting in the jagged appearance on the surface. Air trapped in glacial ice can be subjected to as much as 750 pounds of pressure per square inch. When the ice begins to melt or when the glacier is calving, a popping sound can be heard as the trapped air is released. When millions of trapped air bubbles burst simultaneously, a crackling sound is produced known as ice sizzle or bergy seltzer.

## Hubbard Glacier and the Russell Fjord Wilderness

The Hubbard Glacier was named after Gardiner G. Hubbard (1822-1897) who served as a regent of the Smithsonian Institution for many years, but who is best known as the founder of the National Geographic Society. The Hubbard Glacier made U.S. news in 1986 when it "galloped" across Russell Fjord and sealed the fjord from the ocean. This giant ice-dam trapped dolphins, seals and other sea creatures in the fjord from June until early October before the dam broke and released its captives to the sea. Our schedule calls for us to be cruising the Glacier area between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm with an approximate arrival time at Hubbard Glacier at 11:30 am. Our Naturalist, Graham Sunderland, will narrate the experience between 11:30 am - 12:30 pm via the ship's P.A. system. You'll want to be on the outside decks, though, if the weather is favorable. Look for - and listen for - "calving", as pieces of the glacier break off.
